

Diagramming Sensory Verbs

(Linking vs. Action)

On a separate sheet of paper, please re-write and then diagram each of the sentences below. Pay close attention as to whether the verb is action or linking. (Remember that for linking verbs, you can substitute a “to be” verb like “is” and it will still make sense.)

- 1) At the chef’s request, we tasted the chili.
- 2) The chili tasted very spicy.
- 3) The cook looked unhappy about our comments.
- 4) Yesterday the pizza in the school cafeteria looked good.
- 5) My friend and I looked at the pizza suspiciously.
- 6) Then Mr. Biagini looked at us.
- 7) My friend felt mischievous.
- 8) She felt a laugh in the back of her throat.
- 9) The doorbell sounded down the hall.
- 10) The teacher’s voice, usually pleasant, sounded annoyed.

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
